Proud showy 10 month old Blenheim boy. Upright in stance, well handled and presented, handler made the best of the ring, exhibit showed off his good points when on the move.

Handsome expression framed by high set leathers, flat skull, dark pigmentation to nose and eyes. Eyes could have been a touch cleaner. Good length to muzzle, soft cushioning. Head carried well on a good arched neck, level topline, nicely developed hindquarters used well when on the move. Firm body throughout for age, covered in a soft silky coat, rich chestnut markings, well feathered overall.

Pleased to award him BPIS.

Happy temperament, showed freely when on the move showing a good profile. Winner had a slight edge on body development throughout. Lovely clean presentation, like winner, eyes could have been a touch cleaner. Gentle boyish expression, soft dark eyes, and high set leathers of good length. Clean line to neck, straight topline, good angles to front and rear angulations. Well defined chestnut markings on coat, nicely plumed tail, coat coming through.

Kept a steady topline at all times, shapely soundly built hindquarters, set on well plumed tail. Lovely soft silky coat texture, clear defined rich chestnut markings on pearly white background. Held himself well on the move, displaying an easy flowing movement, responding well to his handler at all times.

Coal black nose, well shaped dark eyes, good depth to stop, well hung leathers framing face. Head carried well, reachy neck, straight topline, nicely set and carried tail, well angulated behind, giving pleasing action coming and going around the ring. As with his body the coat is at that in between stage, never the less it was presented in a lovely clean soft silky textured condition, with rich tan markings.

When I saw the affix of this exhibit it brought a lump to my throat, as just recently Mrs. Molly Thurston passed away. Many a time Mrs. Thurston would be in the ring together with me when she lived in the London area and attended the local Southern Shows. I believe one of her last judging appointments was when I invited her to judge the Cavaliers at my Worthing Show a few years ago. The last time I saw Mrs. Thurston was up in Elgin which was a half way meeting place for her and me when I went home to visit my relations in the Highlands of Scotland. It was lovely to meet after the Show had finished, Joanne Grossi who will be carrying on the Chiffinch affix.

Handsome Ruby male in beautiful condition, well coated overall, plenty of feathering, deep rich ruby colour, good dark pigmentation to nose and eyes. Manly headpiece, soft expression, well shaped eyes, long feathered leathers contouring the face, plenty of cushioning to muzzle. Sound and firm body development throughout, spirit level topline. Well muscled hindquarters with flowing tail, good bend to stifle, plenty of depth to chest. Showed a steady easy flowing stride when on the move, stood well and attentive to handler at all times.

Used neck well, keeping a level topline at all times. Good body frame and even angulations. Gleaming sheen to a coal black coat covering the body well. Moved in keeping with his handler, displaying a free sound movement in the rear and the front, Lovely soft temperament, charming young man.

Stepped out with plenty of drive covering the ground well, kept a clean outline when on the move. Lovely outgoing personality.

Nicely proportioned headpiece, good ear carriage and length of leathers. Would have liked a touch more of a blaze to finish the picture. Stood upright projecting a well built frame with even proportions. On the move showed plenty of drive and style, displaying an easy sound action.

Surprised to discover when looking at the catalogue after the Show that this exhibit was from the UK. Pushed the winner all the way in this class, he had a very much a look at me attitude, just stood there and showed his socks off. Upright in appearance, determined to show himself to advantage. Handsome Blenheim male, masculine expression well shaped dark eyes, just some slight staining spoilt the finished picture. Good length to muzzle, coal black nose, flattest of skulls, well hung leathers framing the face. Flowing neck line, dead level topline leading to well made hindquarters, full plumed tail well placed. Plenty of spring to ribs and depth to chest. Rich chestnut markings on a soft silky coat covering body well.

Good arch to neck, spirit level topline, and her overall angulations were correct, thus giving her a lovely balanced outline. Lovely size, still quite immature, but has a lot of promise and breed type. Soft silky baby coat, good rich chestnut makings well broken up on a pearly white background. Showy young lady was watching her audience at first, then got her mind on the job in hand and really strode out with good tail action. Stood well for her handler at all times.

Soundly built rear, good bend to stifle, non stop wagging tail. Spotless presentation to coat in super condition. Displayed an easy sound forward action covering the ground well with good drive to rear. Handler getting the best from exhibit.

Held a good topline both on the move and standing. Good ribbing, pleasing length to body. Neat well angulated hindquarters, well placed tail set, nicely boned throughout. Well presented and groomed. On the move showed a smooth stride covering the ground well.

Moved well showing herself to advantage, stood upright and attentive to her handler.

Good quality Blenheim bitch. Really showed herself off in the class, stood beautifully making the most off herself. Clean cut profile, well balanced throughout, with first class movement to match. Ultra feminine head, soft expression, dark brown eyes, coal black nose. Well hung full fringed leathers contouring her face. Lovely arch to neck, well placed shoulders, mature body covering her frame well. Great presentation and condition to coat, well marked rich chestnut markings, has a white collar on her show side which could give the appearance of being shorter in the neck, but she carries her head well thus giving an optical illusion. Firm rear drive.

Another well presented exhibit, softest of coats very well broken up, glossy rich tan markings, good feathering overall, lovely plumed tail, used well. Pushed the winner, two lovely bitches headed this good class.

Really moved around the ring, firm drive to the rear, just enjoyed her showing with a positive attitude.
