1st. - #65 Riverruns Legacy For Glenorchy: (Ch Glenorchys Jack Flash x Ch Mingchen She's All That)

8 month rich chestnut Blenheim with generous head, dark full eye and good pigment. Lovely cobby shape, a little "bum high" at the moment. This young man needs some more training and tail needs to be watched!

2nd. - #28 Brinklow Aengus The Laird: (Ch Shirmont Rhapsody In Blue x Ch Brinklow Alodie Beryl)

Breeder: Norma Moffat - Owner: Gwenne August, Don Mills, ON

7 month well broken Blenheim, a little plain in head and expression spoiled by showing white of eye. Longer cast than my winner with good front construction, he moved much better in front than behind.

Senior Puppy Dog: 1 entry

1st. - #59 Huntingridge Ruff Justice: (Rosssonny Ruff N Ready x Huntingridge Kiss This)

Breeder/Owners: Donna B Schuster & Fritz Schuster, Rushville, NY

Handsome eye-catching rich chestnut Blenheim, mature for his 9 months. Large dark eyes, masculine head with super flat top skull. Good reach of neck and correct shoulder placement and level topline. He carried himself well with good tail, would just prefer a little more muscle tone to give drive behind.

12 - 15 Month Dog: 4 entries (1 Absent) - 3 handsome boys in this class, all a bit keen to wave their plumes!

1st. - #55 Avalcier Princeton: (Pascavale Jamie x Avalcier Electra)

Breeder: Mr. K.M. & Mrs. C.C. Li - Owners: E & R Venier, Leesport, PA

14 months - quite stunning boy in magnificent coat for his tender age – so eyecatching in profile. Gentle head with warm dark eye, so soft expression. Excellent reach of neck and level topline. Correct lay of shoulder and good front movement. Would prefer more drive from behind.

2nd - Loranka's Repeat The Beat: (Loranka's Armani x Chantismere Charon Armani)

Breeder: Lorraine Hughes - Owner: Susan Ling, Murray Siding, N.S.

12 months and very much the baby of the class. Gentle head with full dark eye and good pigment. A lovely cobby shape, so lovely standing, his outline spoiled by his tail on the move.

3rd - Lanola Only Make Believe: (Maibee Make Believe x Lanola Sweet Wild Rose)

Breeder: S.R. Goodwin - Owner: Karen A Matters, Lebanon, IA

Another Blenheim, well broken with so gentle head, dark eye and large black pigmented nose. In full coat, he moved better in front than behind.

15 - 18 Month Dog: 4 entries

1st. - #9 Revelry's Go For Broke: (Ch Revelry Like A Rock CD x Ch Kibergo Revelry Adaptation)

Breeder: Barbara Bond, E. Neale Rolstad - Owners: B. Bond, E. Neale Rolstad, A. Seglev, Thunder Bay, ON

Rich chestnut Blenheim of 17 months, up to size. A little plain in head, needing more cushioning in the muzzle to soften, lovely dark eyes and pigment. Very sound in construction with level topline, good neck and shoulders, he won this class on his positive movement.

2nd. - #44 Cempa's President's Choice: (Timsar Mister Moonlighter x Ch Brinklow Ambergill At Cempa)

Breeder/Owner: Marianne Creary, Georgetown, ON

Another Blenheim, fuller in muzzle and therefore more gentle head than my winner. Lovely large expressive warm eyes that could be darker as only 15 months. Excellent pigment. Another up to size. Lovely topline, a little upright in shoulder.

3rd. - #22 Ministik Roll The Bones: (Ch Shado Run Rush To Ministik x Kilbrook Larkspur)

Breeders: Leah Swatko & Joanne Opel - Owner: Leah Swatko, Chatham, ON

16 month, very rich chestnut Blenheim excelling in topline but needing to body-up to fill his frame. A little finer in head properties and pearly white background spoiled by freckles. Very sound on the move both in front and behind.

4th. - #38 Dreamwoods Lion Heart: (Ch Dubourg Couer De Lion x Malindi v.'t Burgstse Hof)

Breeder/Owners: Laura & Norm McMinn, Fenelon Falls, ON

Ruby dog, lovely rich colour, just 15 months. Rather hard in expression which may yet soften, unfortunate underbite. Lovely topline and tailset but lacking show exuberance on the move, perhaps due to carrying a little extra weight!

Canadian Bred Dog: 1 entry

1st. - #27 Gooseberry's Celtic Keepsake: (Ch Cambridge Celtic Sion x Gooseberry's Maximum Delight)

Breeder: Ricki Gies - Owner: Gwenne August, Don Mills, ON

Well broken Tricolour dog, neat little package who could be mistaken for a bitch. Gentle head with lovely dark eye, just showing a hint of white. Good front construction, level topline, he moved better in front than behind. A real showman who never stopped wagging!

Bred By Exhibitor Dog: 2 entries

1st. - #82 Barrington's Reece: (Ch Barrington's In Like Flynn x Barrington's Fiona)

Breeder/Owners: Harry & Pat Barrington, Stevensville, ON

Ruby dog of super size with correct lay of shoulder, lovely neck and level topline with tail coming straight off the topline. Head has matured, now just needs all the furnishings that he needs at this level of competition.

2nd. - #58 Winbury Rigoletto: (Winbury Ernest Hemingway x Winbury Grace Note)

Breeder/Owner: Laura D. Stebbins, Okemos, MI

Heavier Blenheim boy, up to size who needs more coat to balance the picture. Handsome head with dark eye and pigment. Good neck and shoulders, he moved better in front than behind.

Open Dog: 6 entries

1st. - #70 Miletree Northern Star: (Aranel Cosmic x Miletree Bedtime Wish)

Breeder: Mr. P.C. & Mrs. R. K. Towse - Owners: Dr. Bruce & Shirley Henry, Dallas, TX

The Stars Shine! Blenheim dog oozing quality. Correct skull shape with full gentle muzzle, all male. Large dark eyes giving so kind expression with huge black pigmented nose. At the top end for size for me but so sound, level topline with tail a continuance of. He moved with style and had all the "pick me" qualities that a dog from the top drawer needs.

I was delighted to award him **WINNERS DOG**.

2nd. - #24 Aranel Fanatic: (Aranel Cosmic x Aranel Nutmeg)

Breeder: M.J. Smith & R.A. Aldous - Owner: Lana Adair, Paducah, KY

Another quality Blenheim from the top drawer, well broken, a pretty boy with dark eye and pigment. Of lovely size, a little upright in shoulder, however moved with drive from behind.

I had no hesitation in awarding **RESERVE WINNERS DOG**.

3rd. - #39 Inkahoots Jamaica Me Crazy: (Roi L Give And Take x Inkahoots Rumor Has It)

Breeder: Karen O'Connor - Owners: Clare Pattison & Norma Moffat, Kitchener, ON

Similar in type to 2nd but would have preferred a darker eye, however still giving warm, gentle expression. Good topline, he moved soundly in front and behind.

4th. - #18 Stonehaven's Muddy Waters: (Pascavale Stanley x Stonehaven's Cocoa Amore)

Breeder/Owner: Holly Cornwell, Van Etter, NY

Handsome B/T with well cushioned muzzle and gentle head. Standing in profile he lacks angulation and subsequently doesn't have the drive from behind.

Well broken Blenheim baby, almost 7 months. This little baby didn't take her eyes off her handler and was clearly a "breeze in the park" to show! So feminine in head with lovely dark eyes giving such a soft expression. Compact in size, with excellent construction, lovely topline and correct tail used to advantage. Could have smuggled this one home!

Ruby bitch in super quality coat for her tender 6 months, unlucky to meet the winner here. Another with super topline and tail, so sassy on the move. Very feminine in head with lovely dark eye and pigment.

3rd. - #75 Carver Unmistakably Orchard Hill: (Ch Orchard Hill Here For The Party x Ch Orchard Hill Nevertheless)

Breeders: Chris Hodgkinson and E. & R. Venier - Owners Shelly & Chris Hodgkinson

Attractive well broken Blenheim baby of just 7 months. Lovely cobby shape and well bodied. Soft gentle head, would prefer flatter top skull. Lovely warm dark eyes and excellent pigment. This baby went well on the move.

4th - #7 Shirmont Anna Pavlova: (GCh Orchard Hill Shirmont Backtalk x Ch Shirmont Birthday Trinket)

Another well broken Blenheim, as immature as one should expect at 7 months. A little finer in muzzle but lovely dark eyes and pigment. Excellent in neck and shoulders, she moved well.

Senior Puppy Bitch: 4 entries (1 Absent)

1st. - #45 Kinvaar's Trolley Dolly: (Maibee Montrose x Johnasta Rose Crystal)

Well broken Blenheim bitch of 10 months. Very feminine in head, expression just spoiled by showing white of eye in one eye. Lovely crest to the neck, she moved true in front and behind. Tail set on low and carried a little proud!

Just 10 months, this well broken Tricolour has tan in all the right places! Very feminine in head just needing time to cushion and nose pigment to fill. Good front construction with correct lay of shoulders set off by lovely white collar. Just longer cast than my 1st.

3rd. - #68 Glenire's Bathilda Bagshot: (Ch Llovizna Lane's Sampson x Erin O'Emerald Isle At Glenire)

This 10 month old bitch was not in the same league as my 1st & 2nd. However feminine in head with dark eyes and delightful outgoing personality.

12 - 15 Month Bitch: 7 entries (1 Absent)

1st. - #26 Rose Arbor Hoochie Koochie: (Sherjane Adonis x Rose Arbor's Angel Face)

A cracking Blenheim baby of 12 months that could win anywhere. Feminine head with dark eye and pigment. Excelling in neck and shoulders with a topline to carry a tea tray and tail straight off the topline. She moved with style!

13 month old tricolour with generous head and dark eyes, slightly cross-eyed in expression. Excellent neck and shoulders and lovely cobby shape. She too moved better in front than behind.

Similar in shape to my 3rd this little girl was impossible to assess on the table and then appeared distracted on the move. However as settled she moved well in front and behind.

15 - 18 Month Bitch: 2 entries

15 months and up to size - Blenheim of rich chestnut colour, background spoiled by freckles. Good topline but low set tail, she moved true in front and behind. Dark eyes and pigment, expression spoiled by the white showing in one eye.

2nd. - #73 Mysticmoon's Danika: (Ch Rabymar Adonis x Ch Burbrook Rebecca's Last Fling)

Breeder/Owner: Karen Murray, Ripley, ON

Another of 15 months - Black & tan with rather sooty tan markings. Lovely size and very feminine head with gentle muzzle and dark eye. I preferred the movement of my winner both in front and behind.

Canadian Bred Bitch: 2 entries

Elegant B/T with lovely flat coat, beautifully presented and so full of herself. A little longer in muzzle than I prefer and I would have liked a darker eye. A very sound mover in front and behind.

Well broken Blenheim, again would have preferred a darker eye but excellent nose pigment. A little "matronly" in body shape, she moved better in front than behind.

Bred By Exhibitor Bitch: 9 entries (3 Absent)

1st. - #31 Virgo New Resolution: (Brevens Box Office Ovation x Eis Brei's Heavenly Angel)

Breeder/Owner: Karen M. Wnek, New Frane, NY

Well broken Blenheim with lovely dark eye but could have blacker nose. Very feminine head with lots of cushioning. Lovely cobby body shape with super topline and tail she moved true in front and with drive from behind.

2nd. - #19 Ministik Cambridge Sunburst: (Ch Shado Run Rush To Ministik RN x Ch Dawnaquinn Vivien Leigh)

Breeder/Owners: Leah Swatko & Elaine Mitchell, Chatham, ON

Exquisite Ruby bitch, with the most glamorous ears framing her so feminine head. Missed out on first place due to very light eyes, such a shame. A very sound bitch on the move with lovely topline and put down in tip top condition.

What a treasure, I could definitely have brought her back to England! Well broken Blenheim bitch, so feminine all through. So sound on the move, she caught my eye as soon as she came into the ring and I knew I had found my **WINNERS BITCH** – she did not disappoint! Expressive dark eyes and super black pigment. Lovely reach of neck, topline and excellent tail carriage

Lovely head properties, correct flat top skull with lovely set on of ears framing his generous muzzle. Large dark eyes and almost black nose. So very sound on the move he just covered the ground. In full coat and put down in excellent condition.
