I would like to extend my thanks to the board of Directors of this club for inviting me to judge at their show, also to the exhibitors for bringing their dogs. Special thanks to Elaine and Sharon Ellis for inviting me to stay in their home and showing me such a great time. I particularly enjoyed the theatre visit to Stage West.

It was a privilege to come and judge at such a well-organised, friendly show where the hospitality was first class, the dogs and bitches were all, without exception, beautifully clean, well groomed and temperaments were as they should be. Thank you to my steward, Helen Rose, for keeping the ring in excellent order.

Before I begin my critique on the dogs I would just like to make the following observations - all my major winners were of very good breed type, there were other dogs whose eyes could have been both darker and more round in shape, and a few appeared unbalanced due to a shortness of leg. Sportsmanship was particularly impressive, apart from the one person who came to the ringside when I was writing my critique and said in a loud voice, obviously for my benefit, to an exhibitor who placed second "well you can't win Best Puppy all the time". This, in my opinion, is unacceptable and could spoil a judge's and other exhibitor's day.

Junior Puppy Dog: 3 entries (1 Absent)

1st - KINVAAR'S BELIEVER FEVER: (Maibee Make Believe X Johnasta Rose Crystal at Kivaar)

Breeder: Debbie Kerr - Owner: Marianne Creary

A 7-month old heavily-marked blenheim, whose stunning outline could not be missed. He has a gorgeous head, correct skull shape with a broad muzzle, large, lustrous, dark eyes, correctly set ears and excellent dentition. When looking at him in side profile you see a wonderful reach of neck, well-placed shoulders, level topline and wagging tail set on correctly. His coat is in excellent condition, of a rich colour, silky in texture and gleamed in the sunlight. Straight front, well sprung ribcage and short in the back with well-turned stifles. His strong, true movement was a joy to watch. Although he has a long, brown marking on one of his front legs, this is purely cosmetic and certainly did not detract from the overall picture. In this first exhibit I found my **Best Puppy in Show**. I learned afterwards that he had recently been imported and his parents have some of the best English breeding behind them. I am quite sure that he will be an asset to Canadian breeding.

2nd - DRAMATIQUE DON'T BLINK: (Ch. Woodmere's What A Dreammaker X Ch. Dramatique Too Hot To Handle)

Breeder/Owner: Rynn Dolson-Critchley

Most promising, well-broken blenheim, almost flat skull, good ear placement, very dark pigment, although I preferred the eyes and expression of the first. Lovely, straight front giving very pleasing movement. This dog also had a good reach of neck, level topline and very good turn of stifle.

Senior Puppy Dog: 5 entries (1 Absent)

1st. - TURRETBANK MERLOT: (Rabymar Untouchable X Turretbank Yvette)

Breeder: Katie Sloan - Owners: Clare Pattison, Norma Moffat & Linda Ziehm,

Extremely handsome ruby boy wearing a long, silky jacket. Most of the time he holds a level topline both standing and on the move. He has a most attractive head, exceptionally good nose and eye pigment and correct bite. The cushioning below his eyes was appropriate for his age. Good tail set and carriage. Short, compact body, excellent neck and well laid back shoulders. Good turn of stifle. Moved with real enthusiasm both ways.

2nd - CHRYS-HAEFEN DDLS DIGL GLENIRE: (Ch. Chrys-Haefen Oscar Wilde X Ch. Chrys-Haefen Carefree Beauty)

Breeder: Jennifer McAuley - Owners: Valerie Toth & Emily Toth-Tamminga.

Heavily marked tricolour with a most pleasing overall outline, free flowing movement and lovely eyes, very good spring of rib and short back. Good reach of neck, well laid shoulders and level topline. Moved well both ways.

3rd - SIGMA PIPERS MARITIME BOY: (Sigma Chi's Blowin In The Wind X Ch. Sigma Chi's Sandpiper)

Breeder: Elaine Whitney - Owners: Cathy Westbury & Elaine Whitney.

Well-marked blenheim pup, slightly longer and leaner in body than the first two. Pretty eyes, however nose pigment could be darker. Needs to strengthen in topline.

4th - BRINKLOW WINSMAN MARCELLO: (Der Hagen's Livin Fast Fwd X Ch. Wug A Winsome Brinklow Babe)

Breeder: Norma Moffat - Owner: Barbara Kaziniec.

Attractive headed tri, just needs more cushioning below the eyes. Straight front, he has a good neck and shoulder placement, but looked almost over angulated at the rear. Just too proud of his tail on the move.

12 - 18 Month Dog: 5 entries

1st - CAMBRIDGEMINISTIK CARLOS SANTANA: (Ch. Stepamgar's Copper Penny X Dawnaquinn Cambridge Dear Jane)

Breeders: Wendy Maisey & Elaine Mitchell - Owner: Leah Swatko.

Black & tan boy with rich tan markings. Very attractive looking dog with a straight front, well laid shoulders, short back and exceptionally good spring of rib. His head is still immature needing to develop more under his large, dark eyes. His raven black coat gleamed with health and had been beautifully prepared. He moves out with precision and has a level topline, his tail set could have been better placed.

2nd - TALLYGOLD BASKING IN GLORY: (Ch. Nordictouch Montana X Tallygolds Promise Me Anything)

Breeder: Melva Vail - Owner: Dawn Spencer

Blenheim dog built on slightly larger lines than 1st. Pleasing head with lozenge and very dark nose and eye pigment. His well-prepared coat was slightly shorter than first.



3rd - ODEONS DESIGN FOR QUINDERIA: (Ch. Shirmont Pinstripe Blue X Annquindygrl's Rave On)

Breeder: Donna Rayner - Owner: Carol Steward

Small, richly marked blenheim, well broken markings, his good construction allowed him to move freely. Nose pigment could be improved.

4th - REVELRY SENSATION AT SARANADE: (Kinvaar Obsession X Ch. Revelry's Thief of Hearts)

Breeders: Barbara Bond & Erin Neale-Rolstad - Owner: Penny Freberg

A bigger, blanket-marked tricolour. Pleasing head with long well feathered ears. His coat was very well prepared.

Canadian Bred Dog: 6 entries

1st - CEMPA'S PRESIDENT'S CHOICE: (Timsar Mister Moonlighter X Ch. Brinklow Amberjill at Cempa)

Breeder/Owner: Marianne Creary.

2 year old blenheim. that appealed greatly to me. He is of excellent breed type, has a stunning overall outline and profile, a most handsome head and large, dark eyes. His expression is most attractive, one of his greatest assets is his dense black pigment. He is a super size, with good bone, short in the back, reachy neck and well-laid shoulders. His well-broken coat was of the correct texture. He moved extremely well

2nd - RULERS JANUARY MAN: (Ch. Shirmont Pinstripe Blue X Ruler's Help Me Rhonda)

Breeders: Sandy & Mike Gelinis - Owners: Marg Jury & Mark Hagen

Another well-marked blenheim with a correctly shaped head, excellent pigmentation, long well-feathered ears. Very good top of skull, slightly longer in body than the first, and held a level topline on the move. Good turn of stifle and sound rear movement.

3rd - DELLEROSSES LAST DANCE: (Ch. Dellerose Lord Of The Dance X Dellerose Krista's Keepsake)

Breeders: Dorcas & Stephen Mycock - Owner: Ann Chambers

Classically marked blenheim, attractive head, large, dark eyes, dense pigment and almost flat skull. Shorter in the muzzle than the standard requires. Very correct neck and shoulders, level topline, just spoilt himself by pulling on the move.

4th - GLENIRE'S WIZARD: (Ch. Barrington's In Like Flynn X Glenire Snicket)

Breeder/Owners: Valerie Toth & Emily Toth-Tamminga

Overall a pleasing older Ruby boy with a decent make and shape, pretty head and expression. His coat was slightly wavy but in very good condition.

Bred By Exhibitor Dog: 4 entries (1 absent)

1st - KARLEE PEGLEN RUMBUNCTOUS: (Rossbonny Ruff N Ready X Ch. Peglen Romance Dance at Karlee)

Breeders: Carol Rose, Katherine Rose, Peggy Grapp - Owners: Carol Rose & Peggy Grapp

When this richly marked dog strode into the ring I thought I had found my best dog. He has a broad skull, large dark eyes, long well-feathered ears, correct dentition, superb reach of neck and well-laid shoulders. He holds a level topline both standing and on the move. He has well-sprung ribs, is short coupled in the back with well-turned stifles. He was just a shade bigger than my winner's dog so was awarded **Reserve Winners Dog**.

2nd - BARRINGTON'S REECE: (Ch. Barrington's In Like Flynn X Barrington's Fiona)

Breeder/Owners: Pat & Harry Barrington.

A most attractive ruby dog, richly coloured with a well-constructed front assembly, and excellent turn of stifle. He is the correct size with very good neck and shoulders, has a level topline and correct tail set and carriage. I just preferred the eyes on the first.

3rd - DREAMWOODS LION HEART: (Ch. Dubourg Coeur de Lion X Malindi V.'T Burgstse Hof)

Breeder/Owners: Laura & Norm McMinn

Another ruby boy with a mature body, dark nose pigment almost flat skull but with less neck and not such good shoulder placement as the first two placed. His movement was okay.

Open Dog: 7 entries (2 Absent)

1st - ORCHARD HILL CHARISMATIC: (Pascavale Enchanted X Orchard Hill Never Grow Up)

Breeder/Owners: Erica & Rachel Venier.

This beautifully marked tricolour fits the breed standard so well, beginning with his super overall shape and size, handsome head, large dark, lustrous eyes and rich tan markings. Long, well-feathered ears, correctly set. Well-sprung ribcage, short in the back. He carried a long, silky coat that was immaculately presented, his topline was of the best, with a well-set and carried tail. Flowing positive movement, excellent breed type and charisma won him this class and **Winners Dog**. He was only beaten for B.I.S. by a truly beautiful bitch from the Specials class who never gave up showing for a moment in the ring.



Congratulations to his clever breeders for mixing the best of British breeding in with their already stunning American breeding. Well done also to a most talented handler. I would love to see a tricolour dog, of his type, size and quality come to England.

2nd - STELLAR FIREBALL : (Stellar Heartsafire X Stellar The Vampire Slayer)

Attractive head shape on this ruby boy, pleasing expression, large eyes that would benefit from being darker in pigment. Very good front assembly with ample bone, correct turn of stifle and level topline. Coat was slightly wavy and he was longer in the back than the first.

3rd - HALFMOON BELIEVE IT OR NOT: (GCh. Bolowski V.H. Lamslag, CGN X Ch. Halfmoon Northern Spy)

Breeder: Jean G. Tremblay - Owner: Veronique Matte-Paquet

Tricolour dog whose movement was of the best. Pleasing head, however his eyes could be larger and darker. His coat was in excellent condition.

4th - RIVERRUNS LEGACY FOR GLENORCHY: (Ch. Glenorchys Jack Flash X Ch. Mingchen She's All That)

Breeder/Owner: Ann Chambers

Neat sized blenheim dog, attractive coat markings, pleasing head with very dark pigment, short backed and held a level topline on the move.

Veteran Dog: 3 entries

1st - CH. SHIRMONT RHAPSODY IN BLUE: (Ch. Hurleaze Bristol Blue X Ch. Shirmont Margaritaville)

Breeder: Shirley Henry - Owners: Elaine Whitney & Dr. Bruce & Shirley Henry

Ultra smart, short-backed 7 year old in gleaming condition. Handsome head with large, dark sparkling eyes, rich coat colouring and very good spring of rib. Really good outline on the move, ever wagging tail. Again very good breed type and a good mix of British and American breeding.

2nd - CH. BARNESBRIDGE GIBERISH: (Ch. Craigowl Ghillie X Ch. Lymrey Ginette)

Breeder: Colin & Anita Barnes - Owner: Judy McArthur

Another lovely, richly marked blenheim. His expression was just spoilt by panting, the heat of the day certainly didn't help. His well-presented coat was in excellent condition, large blenheim lozenge enhanced his attractive head. For me he was just slightly shorter on the leg and therefore not as well-balanced as first.

3rd - STELLAR PROWLER AT TYCWN: (Woodstock Got The Hots at Falling Springs X Stellar Quasar)

Breeder: Mary Louise Gregg - Owner: Ann Knauss.

Larger B/T boy, 11 years old. Slightly longer in the muzzle than first two above and his eyes were just beginning to show his age. However he was a very happy dog who strode out very well.

4th - PLANTAGENET'S BUDDY, CGN, PCD, CD, RNMCL, RNT, RA, AGNV, AGIJV:

(Dellerose Plantagenet's Sundance X Plantagenet's Mindy)

Blenheim dog with a well-marked coat, again his pigment was showing age. However he has a good reach of neck and level topline.

Bitch Classes:

Junior Puppy Bitch: 3 entries

1st - BURBROOK SNOW FLURRY: (Rossonny Ruff N Ready X Ch. Burbrook Tequila Sunrise)

Breeder/Owner: Peggy Wallace

What a beautiful name for a truly beautiful, well-broken blenheim of only 6 months. She was extremely well-constructed, straight front with well-laid shoulders and ample reach of neck. A pretty head, large, dark eyes framed by long, well-feathered ears. Excellent dentition. She is short in the back, carrying her well-set tail so correctly. Her rear movement still needs to strengthen and with age and maturity she will trouble the best, I'm sure. **Best Puppy Bitch.**

2nd - DRAMATIQUE SWEET TREAT: (Ch. Woodmere's What A Dreammaker X Ch. Dramatique Too Hot To Handle)

Breeder/Owner: Rynn Dolson-Critchley.

Richly marked blenheim, well-balanced in profile. Endearing expression, uses her ears well. A quality coat developing. Correct size, moved out very smartly.

3rd - BURBROOK STORMY WEATHER: (Rossonny Ruff N Ready X Ch. Burbrook Tequila Sunrise)

Breeder: Peggy Wallace - Owners: Darlene Petralia & Carol

Litter sister to the winner of the class, richly coloured blenheim with many similar attributes. Her head, whilst attractive,



still needs to develop and fill under the eyes. Short in the back, level topline and well-turned stifles. Her movement was okay, straight at the front but still needing to strengthen at the rear. Very well handled.

Senior Puppy Bitch: 7 entries

Two very nice but quite different in type puppies headed this class, I just preferred the shortness of back and strong rear movement of the first.

1st - RIVERRUN'S PRIDE OF GLENORCHY: (Ch. Riverrun Rocky Mtn Special, RN X Ch. Mingchen She's All That)
Breeder: Barbara Lowden - Owner: Ann Chambers

Lightly marked blenheim with rich markings. Compact body shape, well-sprung ribcage showing a well-balanced profile. Large, dark eyes, ample ear length, correct dentition. She both stood and moved with a spirit level topline and well-set tail carriage, wagging her tail happily as she moved.

2nd - JEWELCROFT'S DALA MIDNATT SOL: (Jovan Royal Rock N Roll X Campanard's Eternell)

Breeder/Owner: Bonnie Sands

A B/T bitch with rich tan markings whose coat was immaculate in presentation and so expertly handled. Pretty head and eyes, long well-feathered ears. Slightly longer in back than first. She moved well, both coming and going away from me.

3rd - BANNER'S TAKE THE CAKE AT BLUEWILLOW: (Hillwood Diamond Jim X Banner Lil' Lulu)

Breeders: Linda Ziehm & Peggy Knights - Owners: Anna Howard & Linda Ziehm

Lovely size on this tricolour, endearing expression, dark eyes and long, well-feathered ears. Short coupled with well-turned stifles.

4th - WINROB'S BORDER CROSSING: (Angel's Pride A Romanov X Ch. Winrob And All That Jazz)

Breeder/Owner: Donna Robillard

This bitch had a real showy attitude, attractive outline both in profile and on the move.

12 - 18 Month Bitch: 12 entries

1st - HILLWOOD DIAMOND DIVA: (Ch. Hillwood Picture This X Winbury Hillwood Little Jewel)

Breeder: Juli L. Bennett - Owners: Margaret Miller & Juli L. Bennett

Most attractively marked blenheim bitch, of excellent breed type. Shown impeccably by her handler and so sensitively. A lesson in handling skills could certainly be learnt from this gentleman. This bitch has the prettiest of heads, large, dark round eyes, dense nose pigment and long well-feathered ears. Her arched neck, well laid shoulders, very good spring of rib stood out, along with a level topline and well-turned stifles. All of these attributes, along with very sound movement won her **Reserve Winners Bitch**.

2nd - CAMPANARD'S KALLA SELINE: (Campanards Thinks He's Tuff X Campanard's American Beauty)

Breeder: Britt-Louise Candika - Owner: Joanne Grossi

A rather special ruby bitch with such an attractive head, ample cushioning, large dark eyes and long well-feathered ears. Extremely good neck and shoulder placement, level topline and well-set tail. Showy attitude that kind of demands attention.

3rd - ABBYMANOR BELIEVE TO HAVADREAM: (Ch. Shirmont Rhapsody in Blue X Ch. Woodmere's Queen of Winterfest)

Breeder: Judith Weir - Owner: Veronique Matte-Paquet

Larger type of blenheim with a shorter muzzle that tends to give a slightly overdone in the head look. Well-broken markings, dark pigmentation and mature body shape.

4th - WINROB THYME SQUARE: (Ch. Craigowl Ryton, JW X Winrob Tri Working The Puzzle)

Breeder/Owner: Donna Robillard

An attractively marked tricolour of a lovely size, pretty head and eyes.

Canadian Bred Bitch: 3 entries

1st - BARRINGTON LADY OF BLAIRQUHAN: (Kinvaar Obsession X Barrington's Eden)

Breeder/Owners: Pat & Harry Barrington.

This well-broken tricolour bitch, in beautiful coat and condition, impressed me so much with her exceptionally good profile both standing and on the move. Her attractive head, of good shape with rich tan markings only needs slightly more cushioning beneath the eyes. Long well-feathered ears framed her face. Correct dentition. Excellent neck and shoulder placement, level topline and well-placed tail. Her very sound movement won her this placing. **Winners Bitch and Award of Merit**.



2nd - BRINKLOW SCOTTISH BLUEBELL: (Ch. Shirmont Rhapsody in Blue X Ch. Brinklow Alodie Beryl)

Breeder/Owner: Norma Moffat

Very pretty blenheim, short coupled and with good depth of chest. Ample cushioning beneath her pretty eyes. Whilst she moved out soundly I preferred the reach of neck of the first.

3rd - MYSTICMOON'S DANIKA: (Ch. Raby mar Adonis X Ch. Burbrook Rebecca's Last Fling)

Breeder: Karen Murray - Owners: Mary Beth Squirrell & Karen Murray

A mature B/T whose muzzle was slightly shorter than the standard asks for, her tan markings were sooty. She held a level topline on the move and had very good spring of rib.

Bred By Exhibitor Bitch: 4 entries

1st - MADRIGAL S'WONDERFUL: (Ch. Shirmont Rhapsody in Blue X Ch. Madrigal Kiss Me Kate)

Breeder/Owner: Beverley Dent

Blenheim bitch with gorgeous, large lustrous, dark eyes. This bitch is very well constructed, has a well-sprung ribcage, short in the back and was a real pleasure to watch on the move.

2nd - BARRINGTON'S PORTIA: (Ch. Raby mar Adonis X Barrington's Fiona)

Breeder/Owners: Pat & Harry Barrington

B/T bitch with an excellent reach of neck, level topline and correct tail carriage. Attractive head, although I preferred the eyes of the first in this class. Very good straight front, well-laid shoulders and well-turned stifles made this bitch so sound on the move.

3rd - BANNER'S ANY OTHER NAME AT BLUEWILLOW: (Ch. Hillwood Picture This X Banner's Dreamaker)

Short-coupled tricolour, immaculately presented. Very pretty head, pleasing eyes, but again slightly shorter in muzzle. Exceptionally sound rear driving movement.

4th - ABBYMANOR'S HARVEST MOON: (Ch. Shirmont Rhapsody in Blue X Ch. Woodmere's Queen of Winterfest)

Breeder/owner: Judith Weir

Richly marked bitch, slightly plainer in head and shorter in neck than above. Her pigmentation could be better.

Open Bitch: 7 entries (2 absent)

1st - KINVARR'S TROLLEY DOLLY: (Maibee Montrose X Johnasta Rose Crystal at Kinvaar)

Breeder: Debbie Kerr; owner: Marianne Creary

Classically marked, well-broken blenheim bitch. Most attractive outline, short-backed with an excellent spring of rib. Ample reach of neck. Prettiest of heads with large, dark eyes, just shows a touch of white in one eye. Long well-feathered ears and beautifully conditioned coat of silky texture. Level topline and well-turned stifles.

2nd - KARLEE GRAY STONE HIGH SOCIETY: (Ch. Craigowl Ryton X Karlee's Into The Mystic)

Breeders: Carol Rose, Darlene Petralia, K. Rose, J. Ioia - Owner: Mary Pat Brunson

Richly coloured blenheim, very pretty head but not as dark pigmentation as 1st. When standing she tended to overstretch at the rear making her look as though she was straight in stifle.

3rd - BRINKLOW RARE NIKA: (Ch. Raby mar Adonis X Ch. Brinklow Alodie Beryl)

Breeder/Owner: Norma Moffat

Mature B/T bitch that needs more neck to balance her outline. Rich tan markings. Her face could have more cushioning. Coat presentation was excellent.

4th - MADRIGAL I DREAMED A DREAM (Ch. Brinklow Dr Who at AbbyManor X Madrigal Mazurka)

Tricolour in a slightly larger mould than the others placed here. Mature body, good shape, pleasing head with large, dark eyes and long well-feathered ears.

Veteran Bitch: 3 entries

1st - CH. WOODMERE'S PRINCESS TARA: (Ch. Brinklow Barrington Flashback X Ch. Brinklow Woodmere's Chime)

Breeder/Owner: Joan MacIntyre

Regal 9 year old blenheim, most attractive expression, very pretty large, dark eyes. Silky coat in wonderful condition. Dark nose pigment. Well-laid shoulders, level topline and exceptionally good tail carriage. A real credit to her owner.



2nd - BURBROOK OPAL AT JEWELCROFT: (Ch. Millhill Le Reve X Ch. Burbrook Optical Illusion)

Mature tricolour with a well-marked coat, with some fleck marks. Pleasing head and expression, just a touch proud of her tail today.

3rd - DAWNAQUINN VIVIEN LEIGH: (Ch. Coralaw Wishes 'N' Dreams X Ch. Cambridge Rita Mae)

Short-backed B/T with rich tan markings. A very happy showgirl who did not look as well balanced as previous two.

This bitch could not be missed in any class of Champions for her very special breed type, correct size and outstanding movement that comes from excellent construction. She has the most beautiful head, large lustrous eyes, long well-feathered ears and ample cushioning below the eyes. Straight front assembly, very well-laid shoulders and reach of neck. Her topline and tail carriage were just perfect. Her richly marked coat was in the best of condition. It gleamed in the sunshine.
